- Could you provide examples of the areas that would be considered for an optional ‘common approach’ in regards to implementing Pillars 1 and 2?
- Could you explain what a ‘significantly expanded set of indicators for updating the Global Markets strategy’ entails as noted in Item 4c - Horizontal Refresh?
- Could you explain the process for employing new staff members within the Jersey London office and in particular the new Head of European Relations?
