**Quarterly Public Hearing [Witness: Chief Minister] – 3rd March 2022**

The Corporate Services Scrutiny Panel [the Panel] have recently been informed by Government Officers that you will be out of the Island on official business from the 2nd until 14th March 2022 and, that the Panel will need to reschedule the Quarterly Public Hearing with yourself scheduled to take place on Friday 3rd March 2022.

The Panel would appreciate it if you could confirm the detail of the official business being undertaken which limits your availability to attend the Quarterly Public Hearing with the Panel from the 2nd until 14th March 2022.
